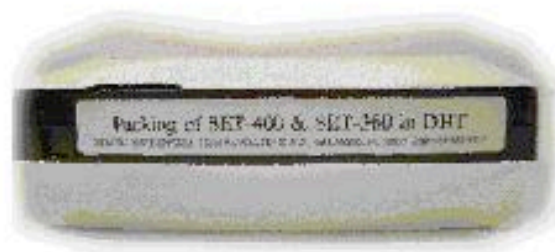


Two Important...Dual Hawk™ Tandem System Videos Released.
