Currency Requirements

90-180 days

A Tandem Instructor that has not made at least three tandem jumps within the last 90-180 days, with at least one of those being on a Dual Hawk Tandem System, must become current by making three jumps with an experienced skydiver as the passenger. The passenger must be instructed in drogue deployment and safety handle use. In addition, a ripcord for main canopy deployment must be attached to his harness and the safety handles which allow the passenger to cut away and pull the reserve must be in place.

Six Months - 1 year

A Tandem Instructor that has not made at least three tandem jumps within the last 180 days to 1 year, with at least one of those being on a Dual Hawk Tandem System, must become current by making three jumps with a current Tandem Instructor as the passenger. The current Tandem Instructor / passenger must be instructed in drogue deployment and safety handle use. In addition, a ripcord for main canopy deployment must be attached to the passenger's harness and the safety handles which allow the passenger to cut away and pull the reserve must be in place.

One Year -

if a Tandem Instructor has made no tandem jumps in over one year, he must take a refresher course from a designated Tandem Examiner.
